OUR MISSION:

We partner with international, national and civil society actors by providing them with prompt, impartial and professional expertise, tailored to each context, to investigate international crimes and serious human rights violations and to promote the rights and access to justice of victims and survivors.



WE MAKE JUSTICE POSSIBLE

INTERNATIONALLY:

By supporting international and regional justice and human rights mechanisms with niche expertise during crucial phases of an investigation, and by promoting the inclusion of marginalized victims and survivors.

Entities supported include: UN Women, OHCHR, ICC OTP, IIMM, IIM, Commission of Inquiry and Fact-Finding Missions by the Human Rights Council, UNICEF, Inter-American Commission on Human Rights, etc.

DOMESTICALLY:

By supporting national judicial and non-judicial mechanisms to fight impunity and provide redress to victims and survivors, including transitional justice initiatives.

Entities supported include: Prosecutor General's Offices (Ukraine, Guatemala), the Special Jurisdiction for Peace (JEP) in Colombia, the Truth, Reconciliation and Reparations Commission in The Gambia, etc.

BY EMPOWERING CSOs:

We support civil society organizations in documenting human rights violations and international crimes, and in promoting the access to justice of victims and survivors.

JRR'S THEMATIC FOCUS

● ACCOUNTABILITY FOR CRIMES AFFECTING CHILDREN:

The scale of the crimes affecting children in armed conflicts and fragile settings is immense, but too often overlooked. To change this reality, JRR systematically deploys experts to help its partners adopt a child-sensitive approach to their investigations and justice efforts.

● ACCOUNTABILITY FOR SEXUAL AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE:

All individuals – females, males, gender non-conforming individuals, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and intersex – can be victims of SGBV. At JRR, we aim to systematically mainstream gender justice and bridge the expertise gap in this field.
