Short Documentary Project – Survivors’ Path to Justice in The Gambia

Shedding light on a victim-centered approach to justice and accountability processes for international crimes and serious human rights violations.

Justice Rapid Response (JRR) invites you to be considered as the **agency** or **videographer/coordinator (hereafter “the Agency”)** for our short-term project to create a **short documentary** (about 15 minutes) showcasing the path to justice for survivors in **The Gambia** to be delivered by **February 2025**.

JRR wishes to contract an agency that will be in charge of planning and structuring the short film scenario, searching, proposing and securing stock footage, and conducting and filming interviews, and the post-production work and delivery of the final product in relation to the work of JRR in The Gambia.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Justice Rapid Response is the only global facility that provides rapidly deployable specialized justice and human rights experts to assist with investigations of reported war crimes, genocide, crimes against humanity, and serious human rights violations. We respond to requests from international organizations, national authorities and civil society organizations to assist in the investigation, analysis and documentation of serious human rights violations and international crimes wherever they occur. Where possible, we communicate about our activities to draw awareness to the importance of such work.

In this instance, we plan to raise visibility surrounding the importance of the work we do in collaboration with our partners. **Our objective is to showcase victims and survivors’ journey towards justice in The Gambia**, where JRR’s programmes have been extensively present over the years. More precisely, this project would aim to **shed light on what justice means for victims and survivors, and what impact does achieving justice – or not – means to victims and survivors.**
